



# Summary of GNC Team Leader

Our Good News Club® core teams need to remain focused on their goal of reaching every child in their school with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. To continuously evaluate and implement this effort, each team will be lead by a carefully selected team leader.

The Team Leader will oversee the Good News Club team in one of the specific schools. This individual will be responsible for organizing and conducting monthly team meetings, directing the team projects and being an encourager to every member of the team.

## Requirements:

Someone who:

- Has a real desire to see the children reached with the Gospel
- Has administrative abilities
- Is a self-starter and flexible
- Is able to initiate, delegate and bring tasks to completion
- Is able to troubleshoot and encourage
- Believes and signs the CEF® Statement of Faith/Doctrinal Protection Policy/Worker's Compliance Agreement annually and is in agreement with all club policies and procedures
- Has been screened for the Child Protection Policy

## Responsibilities:

- Oversees the entire after-school Good News Club program in the assigned school
- Recruits team members to fill all GNC positions and new team members as needed
- Acts as liaison between the church and the club
- Conducts periodic meetings (weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly) with the club team
- Encourages and supports team members
- Prays regularly and encourages others to pray for the school, club team and children
- Leads the team in promoting the club to reach more children
- Works with the team on problem-solving as it relates to the club
- Attends the after-school Good News Club to encourage the team (if possible)
- Works with church leadership to maintain awareness of the GNC to the congregation and ensure that necessary funds are available to finance club.
- Arranges for a church commissioning service in the fall and celebration in the spring.
- Attends periodic team leader's meetings conducted by CEF to discuss the progress of the clubs and assist in future planning
- Works with the team to be a blessing in the school
