

CEF's Greatest Opportunity -Leading children to Christ during elementary school age





He enjoys sharing who lesus is and how to follow him. What a prayer warrior for his family, peers, and others. Jeremiah lives in a loving, caring, and God-fearing home with his mom and dad. Daily, at home and the weekly Good News Club, he is reminded of the importance to see the parts of himself that reflect Father God, and to treat himself, and others as wonderful children of God. Jeremiah shared his admiration for the Good News Club at the Breakfast. This kindergartner is an example of teaching a child in the way you want them to grow!

Grace, is a lovely third grader Princess who shows her heart for the Lord. Grace accepted lesus as her Savior at 5 years old! She always has her hand up in Good News Club (GNC) to answer questions, shares who she has told about Jesus, and to lead the club in prayer. Singing is a gift and passion of Grace. PHASE 1: JUNE 10

This 1-day hands-on workshop is the kick-off to your 4-week work-study program.

JUNE 26 - 30

THE BEST SUMMER OF YOUR LIFE AWAITS

If you are in middle or high school, have a heart for ministry and want to develop your leadership skills by reaching children in your community with the Gospel, then CYIA is for you!

To be a part of the Summer Ministry Leadership Program you need to have accepted Jesus as your Savior and belong to a Bible-believing church.

This Summer you can:

- Reach Boys and Girls with the Gospel
- Build new friendships that will last a lifetime
- Gain leadership skills for ministry in your own local church, school, or location

WHAT IS CYIA?

Christian Youth in Action is a short-term summer ministry internship program for young people from 14 to college age. Interns will learn how to effectively teach children about God and present the Gospel using methods and curriculum developed by CEF. After receiving training, interns return to their local communities and team up with other students to teach 5-Day Clubs (Summer Good News Clubs). The program trains youth to be leaders in their churches and communities.

PHASE 2: JULY 3 - JULY 7

This 4-day training is conducted at CEF Headquarters (2203 N. Rolling Rd, Windsor Mill, MD 21244) where interns will gain in-depth knowledge to share the Gospel.

WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

July 3 - 7 you will be assigned to a team of two or more interns in your local area. Each morning your team will practice the 5-Day Clubs lesson. This includes, songs, games, missionary stories, Bible lessons and memory verses that you will learn during training. In the afternoon, you'll travel with your team to teach under staff supervision. This will help you gain confidence in your teaching and interaction with the children. You will lead your own clubs for 4 weeks from July 10 - August 4, Monday - Friday, accompanied by CEF staff and you will be impacting the lives of hundreds of children with the Gospel!

WHAT'S THE COST?

The \$525 cost per youth for 5-days includes specialized training, meals, materials, 5 colorful T-shirts, and lodging at Camp Wo-Me-To in Harford County. Camp dates will be June 26-30, 2023. Your church or local CEF Chapter may be able to provide financial assistance.



PHASE 3: JULY 10 - AUGUST 4 ON MISSION

In your local area you will be sharing your faith with children in 5-day Clubs and VBS programs. 5-Day Clubs take place in parks, daycares, apartment complexes, community centers, churches and anywhere children can gather. Here is where you'll put your leadership skills to the test.

WHAT'S THE FIRST STEPS?

Prayer is most important! Ask God for His wisdom and guidance about the major decision. This is a major commitment to God and to the summer ministry leadership program (CYIA). Joshua 3:5– Then Joshua said to the people, "Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the LORD will do wonders among you."

WHAT ORGANIZATION IS IN CHARGE OF THE PROGRAM?

Child Evangelism Fellowship® is the world's largest children's ministry, reaching over 25 million children around the world last year with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
